

Barley Twist Wig Stand Demonstration

The presentation will be composed of two sections:

A power point presentation covering barley twists in general, design guidelines, and the initial phases of constructing the wig stand including layout and drilling.

The second portion will be on the lathe that will cover four different phases of the construction:

1. Actual Layout and initial saw cuts.
2. Initial carving as well as turning coves, beads and other decorative portions.
3. Deeper carving and reestablishment of saw cut.
4. Rasp work to make the breakthrough and final sanding.
5. Q&A's

The intent of the demo is to provide all viewers with the essential steps to complete a barley twist either open or closed for any project from candle sticks to this wig stand.
